

## **WALKING HOME SAFETY**

Dear Families:

As we begin a new school year, we are asking you to review the following safety rules with your child.

1. Students should not walk to or from school alone but should walk with a friend.
2. If approached by a stranger, the student should run away.
3. If a stranger touches or attempts to grab a student, the child should yell and scream.

Talk with your children about the route they should take home and who they should walk with to and from school. If a buddy is not available, students should report to the school office. It is also helpful to “role play” some things a stranger might say to entice them.
